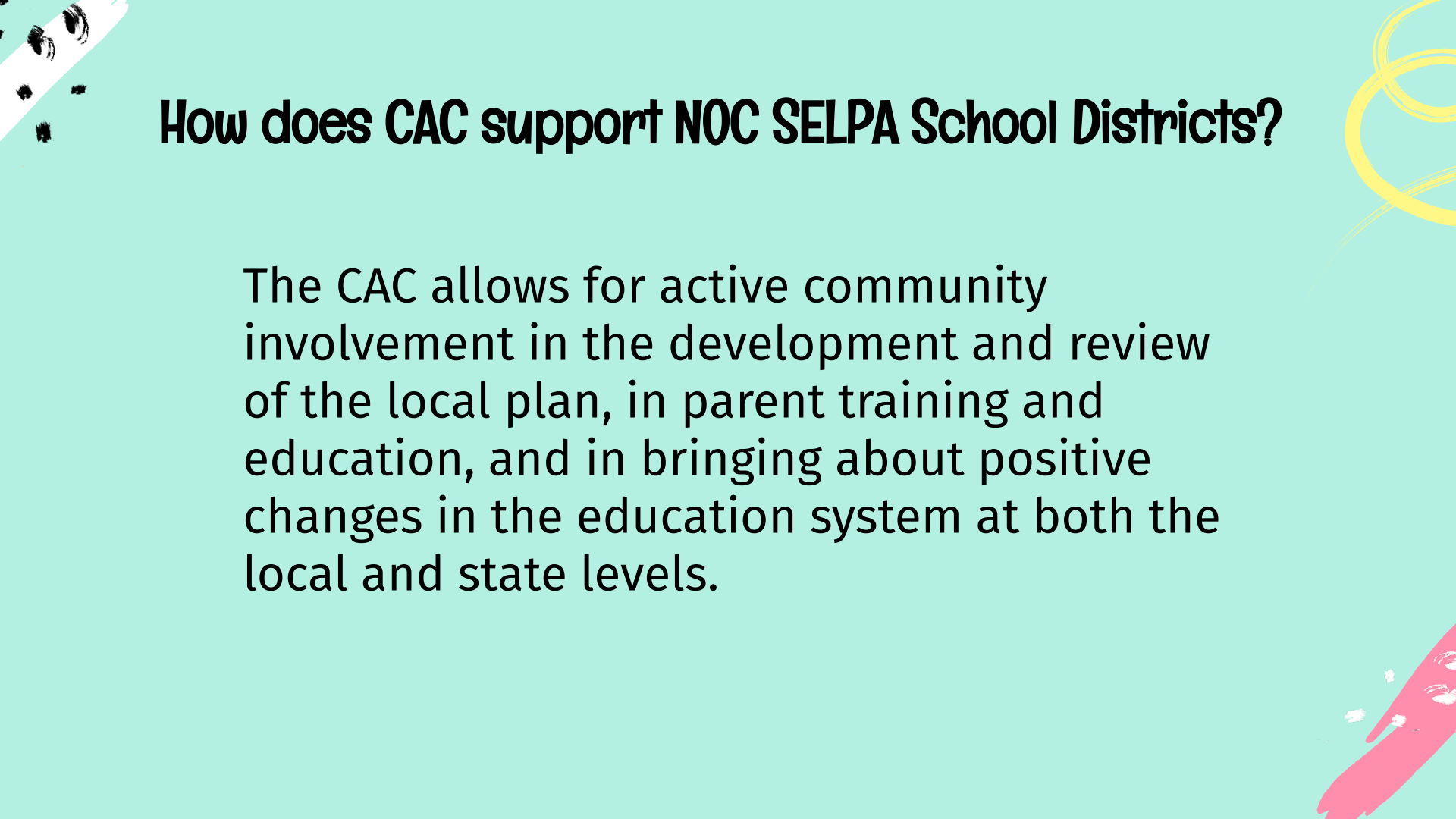


What is CAC?

- **SELPA** stands for **Special Education Local Plan Area**. It is a group of school districts that work together to provide special education and related services to our students with disabilities. Our North Orange County SELPA is made up of **Fullerton** School District, **Fullerton Joint Union** High School District, **La Habra** City School District, **Lowell Joint** School District, and **Buena Park** School District
