Disproportionality and inclusion are still areas of focus. Additionally, preschool targets continue to be a challenge in meeting the compliance thresholds, given that Pre-K is not required, and enrollment was down due to COVID in 20-21. Compliance and next steps will continue to be monitored as CDE shares more information.

9.0 Cost Projection for Additional D/HH Teacher

A discussion was held to review the need to include an additional DHH teacher. Currently, the FJUSHD does not contribute to the itinerant teacher funding model for DHH direct services. A projected cost analysis to include an additional DHH teacher and FJUHSD contributing to the funding model was shared. Mr. Jim Coombs initiated a motion to move this agenda item to an approval item that will be voted on during a special North Orange County Special Education Local Plan Area Superintendent Cabinet Meeting to be scheduled prior to November 18, 2022.
