INTRODUCTION

How much of your trash ends up in the landfill? Use the log below to see where your waste ends up and make a plan of how your family can reduce your trash going into the landfill.

MATERIALS

- Trash Log (either you can print on scratch paper or use the <u>fillable form</u>)
- Pen or pencil if needed
- Trash from a meal or the day

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Review all items that you have used.
- 2. Classify them by the 5 R's (Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose, Rot, Recycle) and landfill.
- 3. If you chose landfill, try to brainstorm some ideas on how you can reduce your waste that ends up in the landfill.

- How many items fall into more than one category?
- Which of the 5 R's is the best option? Why?
- How can you help reduce your trash going into the landfills?
